- Title

- Abstract: Summary of the workshop purpose (max. 200 words)
- Motivation: Why is the topic timely and of particular interest to WISE participants? (max. 200 words)
- Topics: list of topics for which contributions are sought (include reference to the list of topics above)
- Proposed length of the workshop, its structure, and anticipated number of attendees
- Workshop Format: The intended mix of events, such as paper presentations, invited talks, panels, demos and general discussion (either a tabular schedule or a one paragraph summary)
- Related Workshops and Conferences: Is this the continuation of a workshop series or a new workshop to address an emerging issue? Please provide information about past versions of this workshop and other related workshops (including URLs and submission/acceptance counts, if available).

WISE2014 will provide administrative support in the areas of registration, hotel meeting rooms, and publication of the workshop proceedings in Springer.
